Air Force Identity (AFID), Gunter AFB, AL - Provides development and operational support for all AFID capabilities and customers, on-going design, development, deployment, operational and maintenance support. The Small Business Administration (SBA) 8(a) Sole Source vehicle enables agencies to engage in direct buy contracts with 8(a) certified contractors.

Benefits

The 8(a) sole source vehicle provides agencies with a simplified and shortened acquisition procedure:

- 1- Reduced decision cycle: the time required to award an 8(a) sole source contract is usually a matter of days.
- 2- Lowered administrative costs: procurement process and time are minimized.
- 3- Agency can negotiate with the firm directly to get the best value.
- 4- Credit for promoting small business participation within an agency.
- 5- Can initiate contract with a simple, high-level statement of work.

5 Simple Steps to Establish an 8(a) Sole Source Contract

- 1- The government program manager or interested party develops a statement of work, prepares a government estimate, Pre-negotiation Memorandum, if required, and obtains the necessary funding.
- 2- The government program manager or interested party chooses a firm to perform the work and submits a procurement request to the agency contracting officer.
- 3- SBA processes the Offer Letter and returns it to the agency contracting officer who submits the Statement of Work and Request for Proposal or Quotation to the 8(a) firm.
- 4- The 8(a) Program Participant submits a proposal that the agency evaluates and negotiates.
- 5- The agency awards the contract to the 8(a) firm.

These steps can usually be accomplished within a few days. The 8(a) firm receives excellent assistance from the supporting SBA servicing office at 150 Westpark Way, Suite 130, Euless, Texas 76040.
